

SAY NO TO THE DAKOTA ACCESS PIPELINE

Dear Mr President:

I urge you to honor the treaty with Standing Rock Sioux and to take a stand to protect native lands, our water and our climate. Please deny the Dakota Access Bakken crude oil pipeline.

You've made climate change a central issue in your presidency. We must stop extreme energy extraction and deny dirty fossil fuel infrastructure projects, like the Bakken/Dakota Access pipeline, that pose a threat to our climate.

The Dakota Access pipeline would increase our fossil fuel consumption and threaten our air, water, land, property rights and climate. It is proposed to go through tribal lands that belong to the Standing Rock Sioux Nation as stated in a treaty with the United States. The U.S. has no right to hand over this land to a private oil company for private profit.

Federal pipeline permits have already been approved without conducting a rigorous Environmental Impact Assessment, without proper consultation with tribes as required by law.

I urge you to protect native lands, our natural resources and our planet's climate. Use your authority to revoke the Army Corps of Engineers' permits and deny the Dakota Access pipeline.
